

# Africa water storage project

What is water storage in Africa?

For many, water storage is synonymous with lakes or reservoirs, such as the Great African Lakes, Lake Nasser and the Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam (figure S11) and water transfer with large rivers, such as the Nile, Niger or Zambezi, or interbasin transfer schemes in southern Africa.

What is the African water facility (AWF) strategy?

Are irrigated areas increasing in northern African aquifers?
