One thing we need to pay attention to is that the specifics of a BMS may vary based on the type of battery technology (e.g., lithium-ion, lead-acid) and the application (e.g., electric vehicles, renewable energy storage).
Two Types of BMS Block Diagrams High Voltage BMS Block Diagram:

- o The Energy Capacity Guarantee gives maximum acceptable reduction in system energy capacity as a function of time and as a function of system usage.
- Availability Guarantee: o Energy available for charge and discharge as a percentage of time.
- Round Trip Efficiency (RTE): o RTE is defined as the ratio between the energy charged and the energy

A battery energy storage system is of three main parts; batteries, inverter-based power conversion system (PCS) and a Control unit called battery management system (BMS). Figure 1 below presents the block diagram structure of BESS. Figure 1 - Main Structure a battery energy storage system
