

# Lithium batteries and energy storage

Why are lithium batteries important?

Among the myriad energy-storage technologies, lithium batteries will play an increasingly important role because of their high specific energy (energy per unit weight) and energy density (energy per unit volume). Since their introduction in 1991, Li-ion batteries (Fig. 1) have transformed portable electronic devices 1,2,3,4.

Are lithium-ion batteries a good choice for energy storage?

Lithium-ion batteries are being widely deployed in vehicles, consumer electronics, and more recently, in electricity storage systems. These batteries have, and will likely continue to have, relatively high costs per kWh of electricity stored, making them unsuitable for long-duration storage that may be needed to support reliable decarbonized grids.

Are lithium-ion batteries energy efficient?

Among several battery technologies, lithium-ion batteries (LIBs) exhibit high energy efficiency, long cycle life, and relatively high energy density. In this perspective, the properties of LIBs, including their operation mechanism, battery design and construction, and advantages and disadvantages, have been analyzed in detail.

What is a battery energy storage system?

Battery energy storage systems (BESS) Electrochemical methods, primarily using batteries and capacitors, can store electrical energy. How much energy does a lithium ion battery use?

Li-ion batteries have a typical deep cycle life of about 3000 times, which translates into an LCC of more than \$0.20 kWh<sup>-1</sup>, much higher than the renewable electricity cost (Fig. 4 a). The DOE target for energy storage is less than \$0.05 kWh<sup>-1</sup>, 3-5 times lower than today's state-of-the-art technology.

Can Li-ion batteries be used for energy storage?

The review highlighted the high capacity and high power characteristics of Li-ion batteries makes them highly relevant for use in large-scale energy storage systems to store intermittent renewable energy harvested from sources like solar and wind and for use in electric vehicles to replace polluting internal combustion engine vehicles.

The popularity of lithium-ion batteries in energy storage systems is due to their high energy density, efficiency, and long cycle life. The primary chemistries in energy storage systems are LFP or LiFePO<sub>4</sub> (Lithium Iron Phosphate) and NMC (Lithium Nickel Manganese Cobalt Oxide).
